We are looking for public representatives to serve on the College's Inquiry Committee. This Committee is responsible for holding hearings and making disciplinary decisions about the conduct of investigated members.

Qualifications

- Members of the public must not be registered with any health regulatory college

Expectations

- Serve a three-year term
- Possess reliable computer and internet access
- Many of the hearings are concluded in one day however other hearings may require more than one day (eg. 2-6 days).
- If a hearing is two days it will often be consecutive days and you would be advised of that at the time you are selected for the panel.
- If it is determined that hearing requires more than two days you would be asked to provide your availability and the dates of the hearing would be set based on the availability of the panel.
- It is important to note that if you are selected to sit on a panel you need to commit to the all of the dates of a hearing

- All applicants must have excellent analytical and critical thinking skill.

An honorarium is offered. We reimburse rural and northern committee members for expenses when travel is required.
