Meetings are held in person at least once a month. A substantial amount of reading is required in order to review any complaints/reports about RNs, monitor ongoing complaints files and make decisions regarding the disposition of each case.

Qualifications

- RNs must be listed in one of the College's membership classes
- Members of the public must not be registered with any health regulatory college
- All applicants must have excellent analytical and critical thinking skills

Expectations

- Serve a three-year term
- Attend meetings and participate in teleconferences
- Possess reliable computer and internet access

An honorarium is offered for unpaid time away from work. We reimburse rural and northern committee members for expenses when travel is required.
