Purpose:

To set out the requirements for when registration or a certificate of practice are not required to engage in practice as a registered nurse in Manitoba.

Policy:

1. The College will not take any action pursuant to the Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA) where a person who is registered as a registered nurse in another Canadian jurisdiction is involved in the practice of nursing in Manitoba in one of the following circumstances:
 - a. during an inter-jurisdictional transport of a patient for a maximum period of 72 hours as per s. 2.41 of regulations), or
 - b. during a public health emergency as per s. 56(1) RHPA.
2. In order for s.56(1) of the RHPA to apply, written notification from the minister of health is required for the College to waive any requirements for registration or practice under the RHPA in order to allow a person who is authorized to practise that health profession in another jurisdiction in Canada or the United States to practise that profession in Manitoba during the emergency.
