Message to RNs from CRNM

Together with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba (CPSM) we created a document to explain changes regarding delegation: [find it online here](#). We understand that there may be some confusion about the distinction between RNs not accepting delegation of reserved acts under the RHPA and the specific situation regarding the authorized prescriber or RN(AP) role. **RNs practicing in the prescriber role can continue to do so. There is a mechanism in the transitional provisions that allows for the continuation of this practice.**

[The Practice of Registered Nursing Regulation](#) allows for RNs who were initiating prescriptions or orders for drugs or vaccines related to travel health, reproductive health, sexually transmitted infections and blood borne pathogens or diabetes health to continue doing so without a delegation from another health professional. This was happening by a mechanism sometimes understood to be delegation and this practice is allowed to continue for up to two years (May 30, 2020) or until such time as the RN becomes an RN(AP) under the RHPA.

Message to Physicians from CPSM

As you may be aware, the College of Registered Nurses will come under The Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA) effective today, May 31, 2018.

The College of Physicians & Surgeons of Manitoba, along with the College of Registered Nurses have put together a document for your review to explain the changes related to Delegation as a result of the registered nurses coming under the RHPA. The document explains DELEGATION by PHYSICIANS once the physicians come under the RHPA and applies to physicians now in relation to registered nurses who will no longer be able to accept delegations as set out in the attached document.
