## Investigation Committee Decision

### Voluntary Surrender

#### **Background**

While registered with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (“the College”), Matthew Crawford was also registered in another jurisdiction and had an agreement for monitoring of his practice with that jurisdiction for practice issues that arose in that jurisdiction.

On Aug. 1, 2015, Matthew Crawford accepted an undertaking with the College’s Investigation Committee that included the same monitoring terms initiated and imposed in the other jurisdiction.

On Nov. 24, 2015, Matthew Crawford stated to the College’s Investigation Committee that although he had initially accepted the undertaking, he was not able to comply with the terms of the undertaking and that he would not be pursuing registration in Manitoba in 2016. On Nov. 24, 2015 the Investigation Committee accepted the voluntary surrender of Matthew Crawford’s registration and removed him from the College’s register for the remainder of 2015.

#### **Decision**

The Investigation Committee accepted a voluntary surrender from Matthew Crawford and orders he pay costs of \$500.

In the event that Matthew Crawford wishes to seek reinstatement of registration, the Investigation Committee may direct that he fulfill specific requirements prior to reinstatement. Namely, that he will be prepared to accept and comply with the terms of the Aug. 1, 2015 undertaking.

The Investigation Committee believes that this voluntary surrender should be published to educate the public and RNs regarding the expectation that RNs comply with agreements, undertakings or orders.
