Investigation Committee Decision

Voluntary Surrender

Background

On July 17, 2015, while registered with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (the “College”), Wayne Didkowski accepted an undertaking with the College’s Investigation Committee that included that he complete remedial activities and a paper to demonstrate insight and learning that uses the College’s *Standards of Practice for Registered Nurses* and Canadian Nurses Association’s *Code of Ethics for Registered Nurses* as a framework to discuss and evaluate the issues that brought forth the complaint.

On March 31, 2016, Wayne Didkowski stated that although he had initially accepted the undertaking he was currently unable and unwilling to comply with the terms of his undertaking and that he wished to retire from registered nursing practice.

On April 28, 2016, in accordance with section 23(1)(e) of the *Registered Nurses Act*, the Investigation Committee accepted the voluntary surrender of Wayne Didkowski and removed him from the College’s register.

Decision

The Investigation Committee accepted a voluntary surrender from Wayne Didkowski and orders he pay costs of \$500.

In the event that Wayne Didkowski wishes to seek reinstatement of registration, the Investigation Committee may direct that he fulfill specific requirements prior to reinstatement. Namely, that he will be prepared to accept and comply with the terms of the July 17, 2015 undertaking.

The Investigation Committee believes that this voluntary surrender should be published to educate the public and RNs regarding the expectation that RNs comply with agreements, undertakings or orders.
