

Notice of Voluntary Surrender

This revised publication includes the description of the circumstances that led to the member's voluntary surrender.

Allegations

That the member demonstrated invasion of others' personal space, inappropriate behaviour, conduct and touch towards his coworkers.

Findings

The investigation revealed the following:

- A number staff voiced their concern regarding the member's behaviour
- The member reported that personal space was not an issue for him and that his intent was not to make anyone uncomfortable

Decision

The investigation committee accepted the voluntary surrender of the member's registration. The voluntary surrender remains in effect until the investigation committee is satisfied that the conduct that was the subject of the investigation has been resolved, at which time the investigation committee may impose conditions on the member's entitlement to practice nursing. The committee directed that the member complete a fitness to practice assessment by a CRNM approved psychologist or psychiatrist that indicates that the member is safe to return to practice to the satisfaction of the investigation committee before the member's registration may be reinstated.
