ORDER

WHEREAS pursuant to s.34 of *The Registered Nurses Act*, R.S.M. 2001, c. R40 (the “Act”), a Panel of the Discipline Committee (the “Panel”) of the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (the “College”), being duly constituted pursuant to s.32 and 33 of the Act, conducted a hearing on August 28 of 2017 and January 21, 22, February 4, 5, March 4, 5, 15, April 4, May 13, 14, 21 and 23 of 2019 concerning the conduct of Shannon Hancock (the “Member”), being a registered member of the College under the Act.

AND WHEREAS the Notice of Hearing alleges that the Member did commit acts which constitute professional misconduct the particulars of which are set out in the Notice of Hearing and a letter from counsel for the IC dated April 9, 2018, both of which are attached hereto as Exhibit 1

AND WHEREAS the Member denied that her conduct constituted professional misconduct as alleged in the Notice of Hearing.

AND WHEREAS the Panel heard evidence relating to the charges as well as the argument of counsel.

AND WHEREAS the Panel is satisfied that the Member committed acts which constitute professional misconduct.

NOW THEREFORE THE PANEL ORDERS that, pursuant to s.43(1) of the Act, the Member

1. be suspended from registration under the Act for a period of two months commencing on the date of this order; and
2. have the following condition imposed on her entitlement to practice nursing: that the member successfully complete a remedial course of at least eight hours on appropriate boundaries in a medical context. The course should be one approved by the College, taken at the Member’s expense, and be completed by the end of 2019;

AND THE PANEL FURTHER ORDERS that, pursuant to s.44(1) of the Act, the Member pay to the College on or before August 1, 2021 a contribution to the costs of the investigation, hearing and appeal in the amount of \$15,000.
