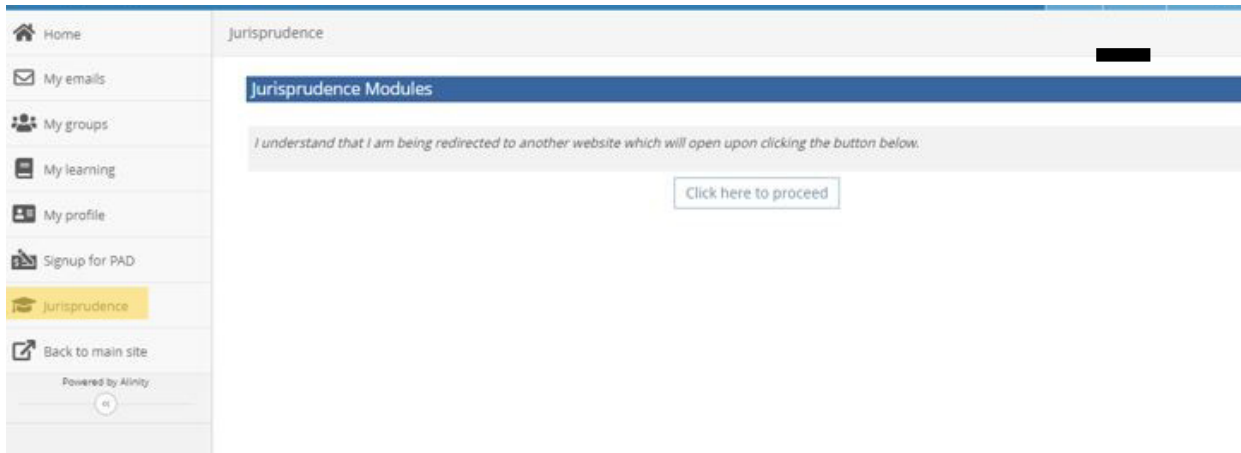
How to access the Jurisprudence Module



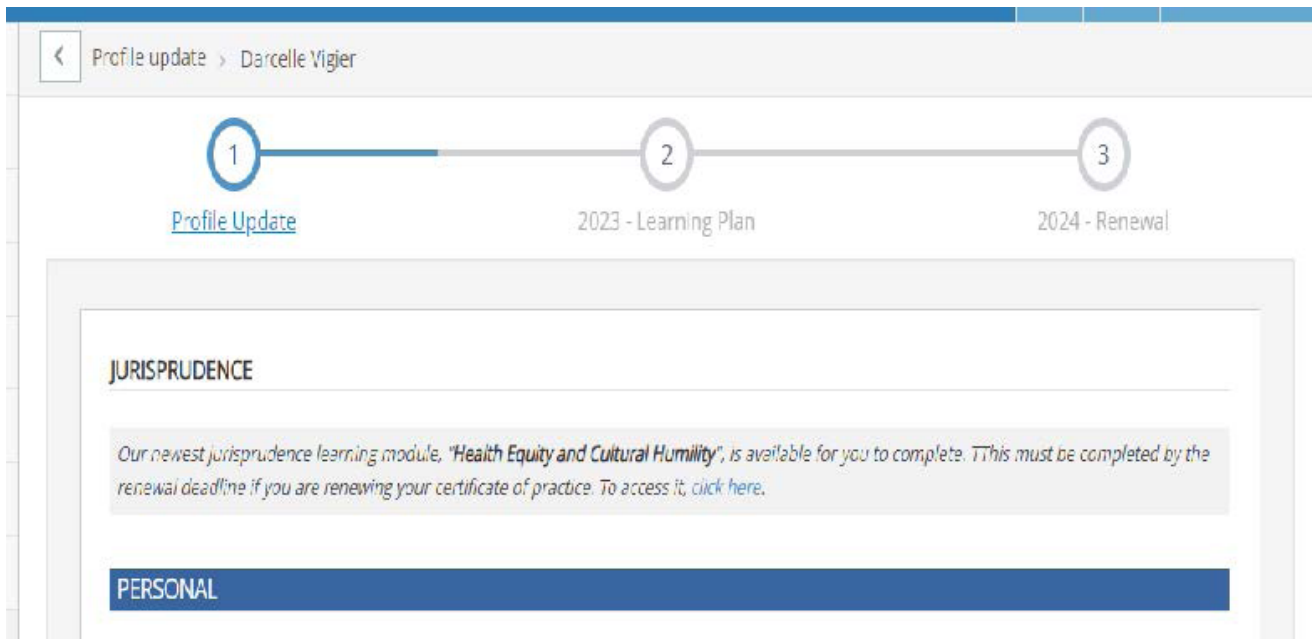

There are two ways to access the required Jurisprudence Module, For the first, begin by logging in to your profile.

1 On the left-hand side, click Jurisprudence. Press “click here to proceed”. You will be brought to a new window and Seismic will open.



The other way is when you renew your Certificate of Practice. When you start your renewal form on the Profile update section, you will see Jurisprudence. Click the link “click here” to access the module.



2 After being directed to Seismic, the modules/lessons will appear. Click the required module for this year. Complete the module, make sure all the lessons for the required modules show completed. The whole module once completed will show “Completed xxxxx (date)”:
