



## **Background**

On December 14, 2023, the Complaints Investigation Committee (“the Committee”) determined it was willing to enter into an undertaking with Ms. Carmen Wilkinson, (the “Registrant”). The undertaking required the Registrant to complete coursework related to civility and professionalism and write a reflective paper demonstrating insight and learning.

On February 11, 2024, the Registrant contacted the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba Professional Conduct staff advising that she did not intend on signing the undertaking and would not be completing the remedial coursework. The Registrant stated that she had removed herself from nursing practice and has retired. She offered the voluntary surrender of her certificate of practice.

### **Decision:**

The Committee accepted the Registrant’s offer to voluntarily surrender her certificate of practice on February 15, 2024. The Committee believes that the voluntary surrender should be published to demonstrate transparency, educate the public and Registered Nurses (RN) concerning the expectations that RNs comply with conditions, undertakings or orders issued by the College.

The Registrant was charged \$500.00 in costs.
