Instructions for Internationally Educated Nurses (IENs) from the United States – Expedited Registration Pathway

Application Process

Our primary mode of communication with applicants is by email. Please provide a valid email address on your application form and check your email (including your junk folder) on a regular basis. Once your application has been reviewed, you will receive a confirmation email outlining the requirements needed to complete the application process.

To practise as a registered nurse in Manitoba and use the title or designation “registered nurse”, “RN” or “graduate nurse”, “GN”, you must hold a valid certificate of practice with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (the College) in the Registered Nurse Membership Class or the Graduate Nurse Membership Class.

This application package is for you if you meet the following three criteria:

1. **Education:** Completed an approved entry-level registered nursing education program that led to your initial RN registration; **and**
2. **Recency of Practice or Graduation:**
 - If you hold a Bachelor of Nursing (BN) or Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN), you must have graduated from that program within the past two years. If you graduated more than two years ago, you must have practiced as an RN for a minimum of 450 hours in the past two years or 1,125 hours in the past five years in the United States
 - OR**
 - If you hold an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN), you must have practiced as an RN for a minimum of 450 hours in the past two years or 1,125 hours in the past five years in the United States. You also need to have a minimum of 3,600 hours of RN practice in the United States, which is approximately two years of full-time work; **and**
3. **Licensure:** You hold current and active registered nurse registration in good standing in the United States.

If you do not meet all three criteria listed above, you are not eligible to apply through the expedited registration pathway and are invited to apply through the standard pathway:

You are not eligible for registration as a registered nurse in Manitoba if:

- You hold an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) and your ADN education is deemed insufficient by the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba. In such rare cases, ADN-educated applicants will be redirected to the standard IEN application process.
- You were not educated as an RN (such as a practical nurse, a licensed practical nurse (Canada), midwife, psychiatric nurse, auxiliary nurse, or enrolled nurse, or other type of health care provider).

- You were never registered as an RN in the country where you completed your approved entry-level registered nursing education program.

We do not keep any documentation received before an application file has been opened and assigned an applicant number.

Step 1 (for Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN)-educated applicants only)

Applicants with an ADN must obtain an educational credential assessment report (ECA). For a list of accepted ECA providers, please see the [IEN Handbook](#) or [College Policy AA-9](#). Once the ECA report has been completed, you may submit an application directly to the College. ECA reports received without an open application will only be retained by the College for 30 days. ECA reports are to be submitted to the College by the ECA provider directly.

Applicants educated with a Bachelor of Nursing (BN) or Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) do not need to obtain an ECA report and can proceed directly to step 2 below.

Step 2

To open an application file, you must submit the following items as one complete package:

☐ Internationally Educated Nurse from the United States – Expedited Registration Pathway

Application Form Complete the Internationally Educated Nurse from the United States Expedited Registration Pathway Application Form and upload it through your CRNM profile on the CRNM website. To access the upload function, once in your profile, under the “IEN” section click the “Change” button and follow the prompts. You will be provided with a “Form Upload” option, please upload a saved PDF copy of your completed application form. You will be able to pay the application processing fee online once you have uploaded your application form.

☐ Proof of identification:

Acceptable forms of identification include a copy of your:

- passport
- permanent resident card
- driver's license
- other government-issued picture identification and marriage/divorce certificate (only to verify name change)

A copy of your photo identification can be uploaded through your CRNM profile once your application has been reviewed by College staff.

Step 3

We require the following items before your application will be considered complete and brought forward for assessment:

☐ Official academic transcripts-

BN/BSN-educated applicants: please arrange for official transcripts from your entry level nursing education program to be sent directly from the educational institution to the College. Electronic documents can be sent to: registration@crnm.mb.ca.

Please note that **ADN-educated applicants** are not required to submit an academic transcript, as your ECA report will contain the educational transcript. You will be advised by the College if additional information regarding your educational program is required once the ECA report has been received and reviewed.

☐ Background checks:

The following three checks are required:

- nationwide criminal record check (with vulnerable sector search)
- Manitoba adult abuse registry check
- Manitoba child abuse registry check

See our [fact sheet](#) on background checks here for details on what is required and how you can obtain these documents. The background check documents can be uploaded in your CRNM profile once your application has been reviewed by College staff.

☐ Verification of Registration:

Verification of registration documents are required for all current and expired US registrations held within the past seven years. The College will use the nursys.com website portal to verify any current and expired US nursing license(s) as part of the initial registration process and will accept verification of registration documents up to three months following registration.

Any current registration(s) from other countries will require verification of registration from the applicable regulatory body/ bodies. Any expired registration(s) from other countries within the past seven years also require verification of registration from the regulatory body/ bodies. These verification of registration forms must be submitted prior to registration.

Complete the upper portion of the [verification of registration form](#) and submit it to the appropriate regulatory body/bodies. The regulatory bodies must complete the form and return it directly to the College. Verifications of registration are valid for one year from the date they were completed or sooner if an expiry date is indicated. Faxes, photocopies and scanned copies will not be accepted.

Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN)-educated applicants: please be advised if your ECA report is issued by NNAS, you are only required to submit verification of current registration(s) as well as any registration(s) held in the previous seven years that were not captured through NNAS.

☐ Verification of Practice Hours:

Verification of your registered nursing practice hours for the previous five year is required from your employer(s). Please complete the upper portion of the [verification of practice hours](#) form and submit it to all employers for whom you have worked as a registered nurse in the past five years. The employers must complete the form and return it directly to the College by emailing the completed form to: hours@crnm.mb.ca.

☐ English Language Proficiency:

It is recognized that a high degree of proficiency in reading, writing, listening, and speaking in English is extremely important for providing safe registered nursing care in Manitoba. Demonstrated English language proficiency is one element of fitness to engage in registered nursing practice. Applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency to be approved to write the NCLEX-RN or approved for RN registration if the NCLEX-RN has already been written.

Next Steps

If there are inconsistencies in any of the information you provide during the application process, we reserve the right to require additional supporting documentation, which may be over and above the items outlined above. The College may make improvements or changes to the information described at any time without notice.

Following receipt of the registration requirements outlined above, your application will be reviewed and assessed to ensure you meet initial registration requirements.

☐ Supervised Practice Experience

US applicants with a BN or BSN who have graduated within the last two years and do not meet the minimum number of practice hours will be approved for RN registration with no limit on scope of practice, with the condition they complete 250 hours of **supervised RN practice**.

☐ Transitional Practice Experience

US applicants with an ADN who meet eligibility criteria for the US expedited pathway will be approved for RN registration with no limit on scope of practice, with the condition they complete 250 hours of **transitional RN practice**.

These practice hours must be completed within one year of the date of registration and accrued with a designated employer as identified in [Designated Employers for Supervised and Transitional Practice policy](#). The employer will be required to provide verification of practice hours and confirm satisfactory practice to the College. Upon successful completion of the 250 supervised or transitional practice hours, the condition will be removed from the registrant's certificate of practice. US applicants with a BN or BSN who meet the minimum number of practice hours under this pathway are not subject to a supervised or transitional RN practice condition.

□ Completion of the *Registered Nurse Practice Course* –

US applicants approved for registration are required to successfully complete the following online course within one year of the date of registration: [Registered Nurse Practice Course \(NRSG-1012\)](#) offered through Red River College Polytech.

Previous completion of the course within one year of your application to the College will be accepted. To enroll in the course, please contact Red River College Polytech at: <https://www.rrc.ca>.
