ORDER



College of

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On February 24 and 25, 2026, an Inquiry Committee Panel (the “Panel”) of the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (the “College”), conducted a hearing pursuant to subsection 116(4) of *The Regulated Health Professions Act CCSM c R117* (the “RHPA”), concerning the conduct of Lesley Selch (the “Registrant”), a registrant of the College.

The Notices of Hearing dated September 15, 2021 and July 29, 2022 (the “Notices”) allege that the Registrant committed acts which constitute professional misconduct and/or contravened the RHPA, the College’s *Practice Direction: Practice Expectations for Registered Nurses* (the “PD”), the *Code of Ethics for Registered Nurses* (the “Code”), and/or the College’s *Entry-Level Competencies* (the “ELCs”), the particulars of which are set out in the Notice.

The Panel heard submissions from counsel for the Complaints Investigation Committee and, at the end of the hearing, from the Registrant, and finds that the Registrant is guilty of: professional misconduct; having contravened the RHPA, the PD, the Code, and the ELCs; and further, that the Registrant is ungovernable having demonstrated an unfitness to practise as a Registered Nurse.

The Panel therefore orders that:

1. The Registrant is ungovernable, and has demonstrated they are unsuited and therefore unfit to practise as a Registered Nurse within the meaning of subsection 124(2)(e) of the RHPA;
2. The Registrant's registration is cancelled;
3. The Registrant will pay the amount of \$50,000 as a contribution to the costs of the investigation and hearing; and
4. The Decision and Reasons of the Panel will be published and made available to the public.
