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## **ORDER**

On November 26, 2025, an Inquiry Committee Panel (the “Panel”) of the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (the “College”), conducted a hearing pursuant to subsection 116(4) of *The Regulated Health Professions Act* CCSM c R117 (the “RHPA”), concerning the conduct of Tammy Wolfe (the “Registrant”), a registrant of the College under the RHPA.

The Notice of Hearing dated November 7, 2024, (the “Notice”) alleges that the Registrant committed an act which constitutes professional misconduct and/or has contravened the RHPA, a practice direction, entry-level competency, and/or *The Code of Ethics for Registered Nurses* (2017 Edition) (the “Code”), and displayed a lack of knowledge or lack of skill or judgment in the practice of registered nursing, the particulars of which are set out in the Notice.

The Panel heard submissions from both counsel for the Complaints Investigation Committee and the Registrant and finds that the Registrant committed acts which constitute professional misconduct, contravened the RHPA, a practice direction, entry-level competency, and/or the Code, and displayed a lack of knowledge or lack of skill or judgment in the practice of registered nursing.

The Panel therefore orders that:

1. The Registrant be suspended from practice for a period of three weeks commencing on the date of this Order;
2. The Registrant pay costs in the amount of \$8,000.00;
3. The Registrant attend and complete the following courses within four months of the date of this Order:

- a. McEwan University's *Medication Management NURS 0161*;
  - b. McEwan University's *Documentation in Nursing NURS 0162*;
  - c. John Collins Consulting *Critical Thinking in Nursing*; and
4. The Panel's decision and disposition will be published on the College website pursuant to subsection 129(1) of the RHPA.
